- ► Identifying persons attending for Domestic Violence court

- A Domestic Violence Duty Lawyer can:
- Give you free advice and information about your legal matter.
- Discuss your situation and the options available.
- Explain what will happen in court.
- Negotiate on your behalf with the other party, the duty lawyer, or their solicitor.
- Talk to police prosecutors on your behalf.
- Help you complete a Legal Aid Queensland application.
- Give you advice on family law or other relevant legal matters.
- Make referrals to agencies that might be able to help you.
- Represent you in court.
