

Women's Health Information and Referral Service CQ Inc. (WHIRSCQ) is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for women, especially those affected by gender-based violence. We also support individuals of all genders and their loved ones who have experienced sexual violence—whether recently or in the past.

Founded in 1991, WHIRSCQ is funded by the Queensland Government Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety. We operate from a feminist perspective, promoting gender equality, embracing cultural diversity, and delivering trauma-informed, holistic, and person-centred care.

Who We Support

We provide free and confidential counselling and support to women, men and young people, including those from disadvantaged or marginalized communities:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples (ATSI).
- Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) communities.

- Women experiencing or at risk of homelessness.
- Residents in rural, regional and remote areas.
- Disability including mental illness.
- Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Intersex (LGBTI) individuals.

Our Services

Delivered in a safe, non-judgmental and inclusive environment— available face-to-face, by phone, or via video conferencing.

General Counselling (Women and youth 14+)

- Support for any issue affecting their well-being.
- Historical domestic and family violence.
- Information and referrals.

Sexual Violence Counselling (Women, men, and youth aged 12+)

- Support for recent or historical sexual violence.
